Thank you for considering a donation to Stonehenge Therapeutic Community. Here are some ways your donation can help us Give People Another Chance at Life:

A \$25 donation pays for a cup of coffee and a light snack for each family member/friends who bring their loved one to their first assessment at the Stonehenge office on Thursdays

A \$50 donation pays for toiletries and laundry soap for a new resident arriving for residential treatment until he/she can get her living allowance from Ontario Works

A \$75 donation pays for fresh bedding and towels for a new client arriving for residential treatment at Stonehenge who may be used to sleeping on the street.

A \$100 donation pays for a set of new clothes for someone coming from the provincial or federal prison system who does not have any clean clothing or proper foot wear.

A \$150 donation pays for a season of plants and vegetables for our horticultural therapy program at the women's residential program

A \$250 donation provides new recreational equipment for the men's treatment program – a new volleyball set or a new punching bag

A \$300 donation will help pay for a residents trip to Ottawa or Windsor to see her children on one of her weekend outings as she prepares to leave treatment and return home.

A \$500 donation pays for refurbishment of a room at the Men's or Women's Treatment Centre – a new duvet, a fresh coat of paint, a new area carpet and wall art.

A \$1,000 donation will pay for a Christmas present for 45 men and women in the residential program for the holiday season as well as gifts for the women and children in our Let's Grow Together Day Program for pregnant and parenting women who are substance involved.
